



Reminders about the SB-CEU process for MITCA Clinics

As some of you know, the State of Michigan is currently in the middle of 'going digital' with regards to both their certification and recordkeeping programs. The Secure Central Registry (SCR) went online on March 1, 2001 with a purpose to house in completeness all SB-CEU offerings and recipients. Additionally, the process by which educators (and others?) will obtain their re-certification for teaching certificates will be tied directly to it within the year. Although it has encountered some learning curve issues, the SCR does appear to have streamlined the procedures that SB-CEU sponsors such as MITCA must follow to award SB-CEU to participating members.

So, we are reminding all coaches intent on taking advantage of the opportunity to earn SB-CEU for clinic attendance that you need to ensure that the address we record as part of your MITCA membership profile matches the email address which you used to establish your own individual account within the SCR! That email address is the primary connector between you, the recipient of SB-CEU (and ultimately your professional recertification) and any sponsor that awards SB-CEU such as your own local ISD or university and organizations such as MITCA or even the MHSAA.

Additionally, as this process has become electronic, there is now a cost for any person that wants to receive SB-CEU. The cost is \$2.50 per offering and is paid via an e-commerce component that is included in the SB-CEU registration process.

A reminder of the process by which one earns SB-CEU for Clinic Attendance.

1. Prior to the clinic, create your online account within the SCR if you have not done so already. There is no cost to establish your account.

2. Attend the clinic and obtain your sign in/out attendance log.
3. Attend each session and have your sheet stamped in/out to earn credit. You earn 0.1 SB-CEU for each session and have to attend at least 5 sessions to earn any credit.
4. *Turn in your attendance log at the end of the clinic.* Do not take it with you. Per state policy, credit is only awarded to those coaches who have the proper stamps and turn in their form before they depart!
5. After the clinic you will receive an email from the state SCR telling you that you have been recommended for SB-CEU. You will have 30 days to complete an online evaluation of our clinic after which, if you *do* want the SB-CEU, you will have to pay \$2.50 to earn the CEU. If you do not complete the evaluation, you can delete the message and you will not be billed. If you do not want the SB-CEU then you do not have to do anything.
6. MITCA will not send out any certificates or documentation; the equivalent is now done by the SCR. You can either print an unofficial transcript of your status or pay the \$25 and have an official copy printed. Again, these fees go directly to the State of Michigan and MITCA does not earn anything from your participation.
